HORSE RIDING AND PARTICIPATION IN HORSE RELATED ACTIVITY IS DANGEROUS

In consideration for being permitted to participate in any way in horse riding activities I the undersigned, understand, acknowledge and accept that:

Horse riding and participation in horse related activities is/are dangerous recreational activities and horses and cattle can act in a sudden and unpredictable (changeable) way, especially if frightened or hurt.

There is a significant risk that serious **INJURY** or **DEATH** may result from participating in horse related competition or activities.

I voluntarily **<u>PARTICIPATE</u>** at my <u>**OWN RISK**</u> and assume sole responsibility for any injury, death, or property damage I may suffer that arises from my participation in horse related activities.

I understand and acknowledge the dangers associated with the consumption of alcohol or any mind-altering drugs before and during the activity and I take full responsibility for any injury, loss or damage associated with their consumption. I agree not to drink alcohol or take drugs prohibited by law before or during any horse activity.

I agree to abide by the Rules & Regulations of the Australian Appaloosa Association and Orange Regional Appaloosa & Central Western Performance Club, and its management/organisers of the activities and that I will follow all directions of the management/organiser of the activities. My failure or refusal to do so can result in **my immediate disqualification** from the activities and the forfeiting of all fees paid in relation to the activities. I understand that any such noncompliance may result in injury, death and/or permanent disability.

I agree to wear a helmet of the currently approved Australian standard in all activities where the Rules & Regulations governing the activity require the wearing of a helmet, I am solely responsible for ensuring that I wear a suitable helmet correctly when required and take sole responsibility for my actions.

I understand that the Orange Regional Appaloosa & Central Western Performance Horse Club (inc) its Affiliated clubs and/or the Management/organizer takes due care to ensure that the venues chosen are safe and suitable, any equipment provided for the purpose of such activities is maintained in good condition and the Association's/management/organizer's staff are appropriately trained.

I further confirm I am in good health and do not suffer from any disability which will affect my ability to participate. I have had sufficient opportunity to read this document, fully understand its terms and sign it freely and voluntarily without inducement of any kind.

- 2. You must compete in at least 2 of the offered events to be eligible for a hi point.

RULES:

- 3. The ORACWPC All Breeds Show is run under AAA Ltd and AQHA rules.
- 4. Entries close 31 October 2024
- 5. There are no refunds after close of entries unless in the death of a horse.
- 6. The Ranch Show and the All Breeds Show will be run as two separate shows. Horses are eligible to compete in both shows. Each show has its own hi point awards.
- 7. All horses must be registered with the AAA Ltd or their relevant breed association to compete in the Breed Halter Classes.
- 8. Any horses competing in events must be registered with the AAA Ltd, AQHA, PHAA or recognised breed societies to be eligible for these events.
- 9. All competitors must be current financial members of the AAA Ltd, AQHA or PHAA or recognised breed societies to be eligible for these events.
- 10. An insurance levy must be paid per horse/rider combination. Any competitors who may be riding for other competitors (such as trainers) must also pay the Insurance levy where applicable.
- 11. All strappers, handlers and non-show persons who are working with horses (including parents assisting children) must pay a \$15 insurance levy accompanied by a signed insurance waiver.
- 12. Copies of entered horse registration papers, association memberships, Amateur membership cards and event eligibility (Where required) must be available at request of show management.
- 13. All EWD competitors must provide their eligibility endorsed by their breed association accompanied by a letter from their Doctor.
- 14. Beginner events are Walt & Trot Only. Beginner events are run as per AAA Ltd Rule Book.
- 15. 3yo Led Versatility This is for Led versatility horses only these horses are not to be ridden or compete in any ridden events at the show.
- 16. All competitors and non-AAA Ltd financial members must fill out the Indemnity Waiver, which must accompany all entries.
- 17. Office and Program Fees are NON-REFUNDABLE.
- Refunds On or Before Closing Date Class Entry Fees MAY be refunded upon Death or Severe Injury of a horse, less \$10 Office Fee per horse. Written Requests MUST be accompanied by a Veterinarian Certificate and must be received by 5.00pm on the closing date. <u>NO EXCEPTIONS.</u>



- 19. <u>Refunds</u> After the Closing Date Class Entry fees MAY be refunded upon Death of a horse ONLY, less 10% of the Entry Fees. Written Requests MUST be accompanied by a Veterinarian Certificate and must be received 24hrs prior to the start of the Show. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 20. Written requests and Veterinarian Certificates will be tabled to our executive committee after the show. Payments will not be returned, if eligible until after an executive committee decision is made.
- 21. Every horse entered for competition shall be under the control of the Show Manager or such person/s she appoints to act on his behalf.
- 22. Only contestants in the specific classes and show officials will be allowed in the competition arena or marshalling area during the judging.
- 23. Riders and handlers must always be correctly attired in show arenas including western hat/helmet and riding boots. Any person not correctly attired will not be allowed into the Show Arenas.
- 24. Show management reserve the right to change the order of classes before or during the show. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be aware of any changes which will be posted at the Show Secretary's office and announced. Every endeavor will be made to give one hour's notice of any changes to the running order of events; however, every step will be made to avoid changes.
- 25. Any exhibitor or rider who refuses to obey the request of the Judge, Show Manager or any show official will be automatically disqualified from further competition at the show and forfeits all previous winnings together with all entry fees and other charges. At the discretion of the Show Manager or show committee, the offending individual and his/her entire exhibit may be removed from the grounds.
- 26. The disputes committee shall consist of the Show Manager, one show committee member and one competitor.
- 27. Protests must be made in writing to the show secretary and be lodged within 30 minutes of the completion of the disputed event. A cash fee of \$50 must accompany any protest.
- 28. Youth ages will be as of 1st August each year, and all youth competitors must have the written permission of a parent or guardian or legal guardian to compete.
- 29. If a horse is vetted out, and it has been entered for competition in a youth event, then that youth can use a replacement horse if the replacement horse has been previously entered in the show. It should be noted that once this has taken place the horse that was vetted out is not allowed to compete in the rest of the show in any classes.
- 30. All youth competing or taking part in an AQHA approved event, must have written permission from their parent/guardian to be at that event as a contestant or participant and in the case of a contestant, the parent/guardian must also sign the entry form. All youth competing or taking part in an AQHA approved event must be in the care of a responsible adult who is in attendance for the duration of that event, whilst the youth attend that event.
- 31. Youth competitors can nominate a maximum of two horses to count towards their High Point awards.
- 32. If an Amateur Performance Horse has been vetted out, the Amateur will be permitted to use a replacement horse so long as the replacement horse has previously been entered in the Show. The replacement horse must be Owned/Leased by the Amateur or their Immediate Family as per AAA Ltd Rules. No substitution will be permitted for any Amateur event with a conformation aspect i.e., Amateur Halter or Amateur Hunter in Hand
- 33. Please Note: In Amateur Select horse age restrictions do not apply.
- 34. Amateur competitors can nominate a maximum of only two horses that will count towards their High Point awards.
- 35. Ranch Events:
 - a. Any horse competing in Ranch Riding is not eligible for any Pleasure events in the All Breed Show
 - b. Ranch Versatility Show is being held as a separate show competitors can enter both shows.
- 36. Led versatility horses (any age) are not permitted to be ridden at the show.
- 37. All event patterns will be posted at least one hour prior to the commencement of the show.
- 38. No alcohol is allowed in, or can be consumed in the marshalling areas, working arenas or show pen/contest areas.



- 39. Competitor's/participants at any event run by AAA Ltd always have a responsibility to ensure the welfare of their horses and to treat their horses humanely and with dignity, respect, and compassion.
- 40. Competitors/participants are to conduct themselves in a professional manner and act with integrity in all dealings with the Affiliate and other competitors. To always uphold the rules and regulations of the ORAC and the AQHA.
- 41. Competitors/participants are to always demonstrate good sportsmanship, showing respect for your fellow competitors and officials, following the rules and to treat people the way you yourself wish to be treated.
- 42. In the case of outbreak of any contagious or infectious disease amongst horses, neither the ORAC committee nor the sponsors or show organisers will be liable for any damage or loss that may occur to any person or animal.
- 43. Competitors realize that horse related competition has an inherent risk and as such compete at this competition at their own risk. The ORAC show committee will accept no liability for accident, loss, or injury. This applies to all competitors, their connections, horses, and spectators.
- 44. First aid officers are available on the grounds available by contacting the show committee. A full AAA biosecurity plan is available at the show office.
- 45. All horses must be serviceably sound. In a case of suspected unsoundness, the Judge and/or Show Management may dismiss the horse from showing in the show.
- 46. All buildings are NO SMOKING ZONES so please observe this ruling.
- 47. Competitors/participants are to conduct themselves in a professional manner and act with integrity.
- 48. Dogs are not recommended on the grounds. If you must bring a dog, it must be kept in the camping area. Strictly NO DOGS ALLOWED in arena and spectator areas.
- 49. Stables and Camping must be pre-booked and paid prior to the event, through the show committee.
- 50. Stable bedding is not included in your stable. This must be purchased in addition to your stable fee. See camping and stabling forms.
- 51. All stables incur a stand bond fee, that is returnable on full cleaning out of your stable BEFORE you leave the grounds. You must not leave and come back to clean. The show committee will be checking. Committee decisions on this are final.
- 52. Any rider 18 years and under is required to always wear a helmet when riding on the grounds AT ALL TIMES, unless in a Western performance event where a western hat is worn. This is a council ground rule.
- 53. No riding is permitted on the outdoor sand arena at any time. This is not permitted for use.
- 54. No dogs are allowed in the grandstands or marshaling area at any time.
- 55. Closed-toed shoes must be worn at all times in the arena, marshaling or horse working areas including the wash bays. The wearing or sandals and/or thong-type shoes is not permitted when working with horses at any time.
- 56. There is no tying to the arena, marshal yard fencing, or the new stable block poles. (Beware of taps and electrical outlets)
- 57. No blacking of horses' feet is permitted on the stable concrete or wash bay areas.
- 58. No one will be permitted in the marshalling area who is not entered in the show or has not submitted a strappers levy and indemnity form (Provided in your entry pack)
